


Mega thinking And The Enchantment Of Positivity

Very often the assembly is addressed by the Principal students to enrich students with their knowledge, experience and expertise.



We take pride in creating an ambience for learning that invigorates and unfolds the true potential of every child, right from the assembly time. We call it- “Praying and paving our way to excellence”.




E.S.M INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY






Investiture ceremony

The club's objectives:






KING MAKER BIRTHDAY CELEBRATION

TRANSFORMING CLASSROOMS FOR 21ST CENTURY LEARNERS


E.S.M- Class rooms –Thinking rooms—Learning studios:




Kargil Victory Day Celebrations

PONGAL CELEBRATION


